HORSE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Only horses registered with the Arabian Horse Society will be eligible to compete, unless otherwise specified for certain classes.
- Foals under 12 months may be entered with a birth notification attached if not registered by the closing date.
- No import horses pending for over 6 months will be accepted.
- All entries will be verified against the Logix system. For example, if a horse has not yet been officially transferred to the new owner, the recorded owner on the Logix database will remain the recognised owner. We will not be held accountable for this. Incorrect entries will not be accepted.
- Incorrect entries will not be accepted.
- No limit on the number of entries per horse

8. CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Participation is mandatory for the applicable qualifiers.

10. PASSPORTS

Owners of horses from horse sickness free areas must remember their passports.

11. GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ENTRIES

Entries are restricted to members and registered breeders of the Arab Horse Society.

All entries are subject to the current Show Rules and Regulations.

All horses entered must be birth notified and/or registered with the AHS of South Africa.

The organiser has the right to combine, divide or cancel classes if necessary.

Minimum entry of 3 horses per class will be strictly adhered to, except for:

- Mare and Stallion classes (12 years and older)
- Children's classes

Entry fees are non refundable except in the case of cancellation of a class.

Each member must complete and sign his/her own entry form.

12. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Any horse breaking loose in the arena or collecting ring will be fined R500.00.
- Only two minutes will be allowed between classes before the gate is officially closed.
- No late comers will be allowed.
- Exhibitors must enter the arena in program order via the marshalling arena.
- Scratching must immediately be brought to the attention of the marshalling steward.
- Non-compliance will be fined R500.00.
- Failing to cancel horses qualifying for a championship and then not showing will lead to a R500.00 fine.
- All complaints must be in writing, submitted within one hour, with a R1000.00 deposit.
- Horses under 2 years of age may not be shod.
- Drugs, ginger or forbidden substance testing may be required at any time.
- Only handlers/riders are allowed in the arena while judging is taking place.
- Only one shaker per horse will be allowed.
- Some selected ridden classes may be held outdoors.

13. FORMAL, SHOWING, DRESSAGE & EQUITATION CLASSES

- Junior Horse: Under 7 years
- Senior Horse: 7 years and older

Novice Classes

A novice horse has not accumulated more than 10 points at accredited shows by the closing date.

No points will be accumulated at this show as it is not affiliated with the SA Arab Horse Society.

Novice Points Allocation for reference:

1st – 5 | 2nd – 4 | 3rd – 3 | 4th – 2 | 5th – 1

Once a horse earns 10 points, it must move to Open classes.

Age of Riders

Children: Under 14 by closing date

Juniors: 14–17 by closing date

- No cross entries between Child, Junior and Adult classes.
- No cross entries between novice and open classes.

Formal Class Attire

- Attire for English and Country Pleasure classes - Informal saddle seat attire is required; no hunt attire. Suggested are conservative colours such as black, blue, grey, beige or brown jacket with matching jodhpurs. Day coat with jodhpurs also permitted. Boots and derby or soft hat required. Contrasting hats, vests and/or ties are acceptable.
- Attire for Hunter Pleasure classes - Informal attire of suitable material for hunting is required. It consists of conservatively coloured coat of any tweed or Melton (conservative wash jackets in season), breeches (or jodhpurs) and boots. A conservative hunting cap or derby is mandatory. Formal attire is not permitted.
- Attire for Show Hack classes - It consists of conservatively coloured coat, breeches (or jodhpurs) and boots. A conservative hunting cap or derby is required. Formal attire consisting of white breeches, top hat and tails may be worn. It is usual to wear such attire after 6:00 pm, or in Championship classes.

No cross entries permitted between Country Pleasure and English Pleasure Horse.

Amateur/Novice Rider Rule

Rider/Handler in the Arabian Division that has won a National Championship, Reserve National Championship or Top 5 in any class is no longer eligible to compete in an amateur/novice rider class, excluded child and junior riders. Furthermore, any rider who has been paid for equestrian training is not eligible to compete in amateur/novice rider classes.

Youth Championships

Minimum of 5 horses qualifying between Child and Junior divisions is required.

Organisers reserve the right to withdraw Youth Championships if fewer qualify or if the number of entries are not enough to justify a championship.

Liberty Classes

Horses have **2 minutes to show** once music starts.

After music stops, **1 minute is allowed to catch the horse.**

Failure results in elimination.

No more than two handlers per horse, **only one may touch the horse.**

Competitors must provide their own music (first come, first served).
